Dear Dutch Oven Cook Off Enthusiast:

We are really excited about your interest in running a Dutch Oven Cook Off. We have enclosed information, which may be helpful for you in organizing and promoting your own cook off. There are several different cook off formats included. You may use one of them or adapt your own. You may also want to add some of your own ideas in one of these formats. To be considered sanctioned by the International Dutch Oven Society (IDOS), which means your first place winner qualifies to be invited to the International Dutch Oven Society World Championship Cook Off (WCCO), you must follow the sanctioned format.

Whatever you do, make it so that everyone has fun. One of the main reasons we want to cook in the Dutch ovens is to have fun. If you want to use some of the judging forms, you have permission to copy any of these and use them. We strongly recommend you use the judging sheets provided as these are the judging sheets that will be used at the WCCO and support the WCCO rules. However, you may use different judging sheets of your own making if you choose to and that will in no way disqualify your winner from being invited to compete in WCCO as long as you follow the rules and the 3-pot format required.

When your cook off is complete, please complete and send back to us the Cook Off Questionnaire. Also please include a story and some photos if possible from your cook-off for publication in the IDOS Newsletter. Your 1st place team is responsible for sending back the IDOS World Championships Qualification Form along with their \$50.00 entrance fee and the recipes that they will be cooking at the World Championships if they are invited. Please also keep in mind that to be considered eligible to participate in the IDOS World Championship Cook Off, your 1st place winner will need to be a member of the International Dutch Oven Society to participate. If they are not yet members, we encourage you to have them join IDOS as soon as possible. They must be members when the form is sent in and also current members at the WCCO if they are invited. Without this they are not eligible to compete in the IDOS World Championships.

We hope this information will help you and if we can further assist you, please E-Mail or call us with your request and we will try to accommodate you. Thanks again and keep cooking and sharing your knowledge, expertise and love of dutch oven cooking with the world.
